Your request for information was received on March 5<sup>th</sup> 2015 and was dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. Please be advised that the Business Services Organisation (BSO) has now completed its search for the information you requested with regards to the race/ethnicity breakdown in the Regulation and Quality Improvement Authority (RQIA).

The table below shows the race/ethnicity breakdown of all employees in RQIA.

<b>Race/Ethnicity</b>	<b>Numbers of staff</b>
Not assigned	93.75%
White	6.25%

The table below shows the race/ethnicity breakdown of RQIA Senior Management.

<b>Race/Ethnicity</b>	<b>Numbers of staff</b>
Not assigned	100%

Please note that for the purposes of identification of senior management employees, we have taken these to be at Band 8c and above. This will include Executive Directors and Heads of Service.

In relation to the categories in the tables above who are recorded as 'not assigned', I wish to advise that these are employees who have not advised us of their race/ethnicity. The RQIA has a new Human Resources system which will enable employees to update these details via a self-service functionality. It is hoped that over time, employees will update these details.

I hope that the information provided assists you. If you are dissatisfied in any way with the handling of your request, you have the right to request a review. You should do this as soon as possible or in any case within two months of the date of issue of this letter.
